





Multi-Year Comparisson



However, for many children, summer can mean hunger. Children receiving free or reduced-priced meals during the school year may go hungry in the summer. End Summer Hunger is North Gwinnett Co-Op's grassroots effort to ensure that kids on summer break have enough to eat when meals at school are not available. This annual campaign brings together local businesses, organizations, schools and individuals to raise funds to provide supplemental food for families.
